- #1 *Respectable Sins – Confronting the Sins We Tolerate*, 8 Studies, Level 2. Led by Barb Ballee. (Continued from fall session.)
- #2 *Proverbs – A Life Changing Encounter With God’s Word From the Book of Proverbs*, 15 studies, Level 3. This study explores the book’s timeless teachings and helpful guidelines on many aspects of personal conduct, including: goodness and sin, wealth and poverty, pride and humility, justice and vengeance, strife and friendships, friendships and family, life and death. Led by Betsy Haraf & Carol Pederson.
- #3 *Exodus*, 24 Studies, Level 2. Led by Joyce Zender & Sue Hoerauf. (Continued from fall session.)
- #4 *Mark – A Life Changing Encounter With God’s Word From the Book of Mark*, 17 studies, Level 3. Mark vigorously defends the claim that Jesus was the true Messiah and that His own people, the Jews, rejected Him because He came not as the glorious warrior-king they expected but as a suffering servant. This study shows us a powerful message of salvation, inspiration, and encouragement. Led by Lois Armstrong & Sharon Nelson.

- #5 *1 & 2 Peter, Jude: Called for a Purpose*, 13 Studies, Level 2. The letters of Peter and Jude challenge you to recognize your identity as a chosen friend of God, and therefore, to live a holy life. Originally addressed to persecuted believers of the first century, you’ll be encouraged to face trials with a living hope, certain of Christ’s return, and be warned of the danger of false teaching and spiritual lethargy. Led by Anne Hugo & Betty Biggerstaff.
- #6 *End Times*, 13 Studies, Level 2. Do you wonder about the “end times” - when it will come, what it will be like, what will happen to you? Examine for yourself what the Bible says about end times. You’ll learn what you can do now to be ready for the future, whatever it holds. Led by Diane Schultz & Margie Lowry.
- #7 *Hebrews: Race to Glory*, 13 studies, Level 2. At times of frustration or disappointment, it is tempting to ask the question, “What’s the use?” You work to grow to Christian maturity, but seem to get nowhere, repeating your mistakes, neglecting your commitments, losing your motivation. Through these studies in Hebrews, you’ll find the encouragement you need to stay in the faith race. Led by Sharon Dykes & Kelly Nelson.
